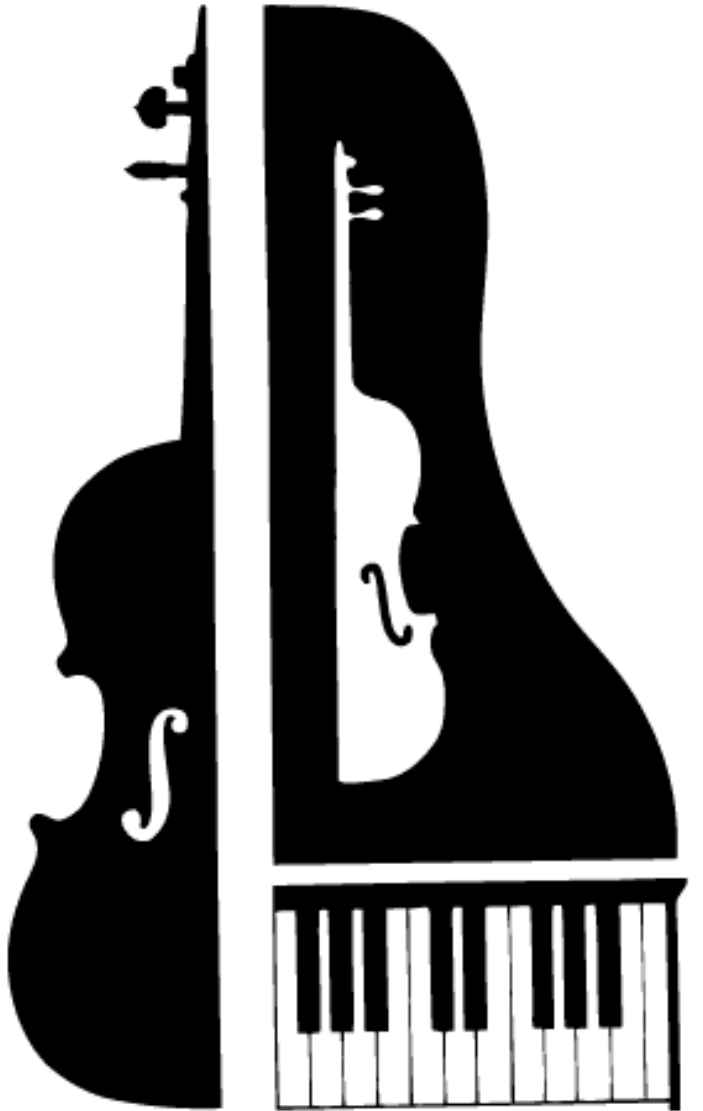

About the Youth Music Festival ...

The Youth Music Festival – formerly the Piano Plus Festival - organised by the Wellington Branch of the Institute of Registered Music Teachers NZ, has become an institution in the calendar of local instrumental and vocal teachers and students.

It began many years ago under the name of the Wellington Piano Competitions and then had a seven-year lapse from 1977. In 1984, the family of Fanny McDonald kindly donated prize money for a piano recital competition as a memorial to this dedicated teacher who had contributed so much. The festival has continued every year since 1984 and has grown to include many other class categories and age groups, including ensemble. The YMF/PPF also owes much gratitude to renowned Wellington piano teacher, Judith Clark, who guided the direction of the festival in many positive ways. A number of the teachers whose students are playing this weekend were themselves students of Judith Clark and/or have also participated in IRMTNZ festivals and competitions.

Donors for awards and prizes range from private individuals to local music organisations and businesses. Performers who participate in the YMF are pupils of members of the Wellington Branch IRMTNZ.

All performers in solo classes must present a selection of music which includes at least one work by a composer from Aotearoa New Zealand; these are marked with * in the programme. All performers are on piano unless otherwise stated.

Special Awards

Award for **Emerging Young Composer**, who will receive a voucher or choose music from SOUNZ for an own composition. Performers eligible for this award are marked with ** in this programme.

The **Florence Murray Award** is for the most promising performer on piano. The **Selah Music Award** is for the Most Promising Performer on voice or an instrument other than piano. These awards will be announced at the end of the Youth Music Festival on Sunday afternoon.

Prizes may not be awarded if a sufficient standard is not reached.*

Ingrid Culliford – Adjudicator

We are delighted to have Ingrid Culliford joining us as adjudicator for the YMF this year. After many years studying and working in London as a free-lance flautist where she worked with several known orchestras and chamber ensembles and taught at Trinity College and the Royal Academy of Music, Ingrid Culliford returned to NZ in 1994. Since then, Ingrid has continued to perform widely and continues to give recitals and masterclasses throughout NZ. In addition to her performance work, Ingrid is very committed to teaching.

For a number of years, she was tutor in flute at both Waikato University and the NZ School of Music in Wellington, as well as Co-Head of Music at Nga Tawa School and a Senior Examiner for the International Baccalaureate. She is currently an examiner for the NZMEB (NZ Music Examinations Board) and is sought-after as an adjudicator. Ingrid is tutor in woodwind and piano at Whanganui Collegiate School as well as in her home studio.

Ingrid was appointed as a Member of the NZ Order of Merit (MNZM) in the 2019 New Year's Honours list, for services to Music and Education. In 2015 she was the recipient of the Chamber Music NZ Marie Vandevart Award for outstanding service in fostering a love of chamber music.
